

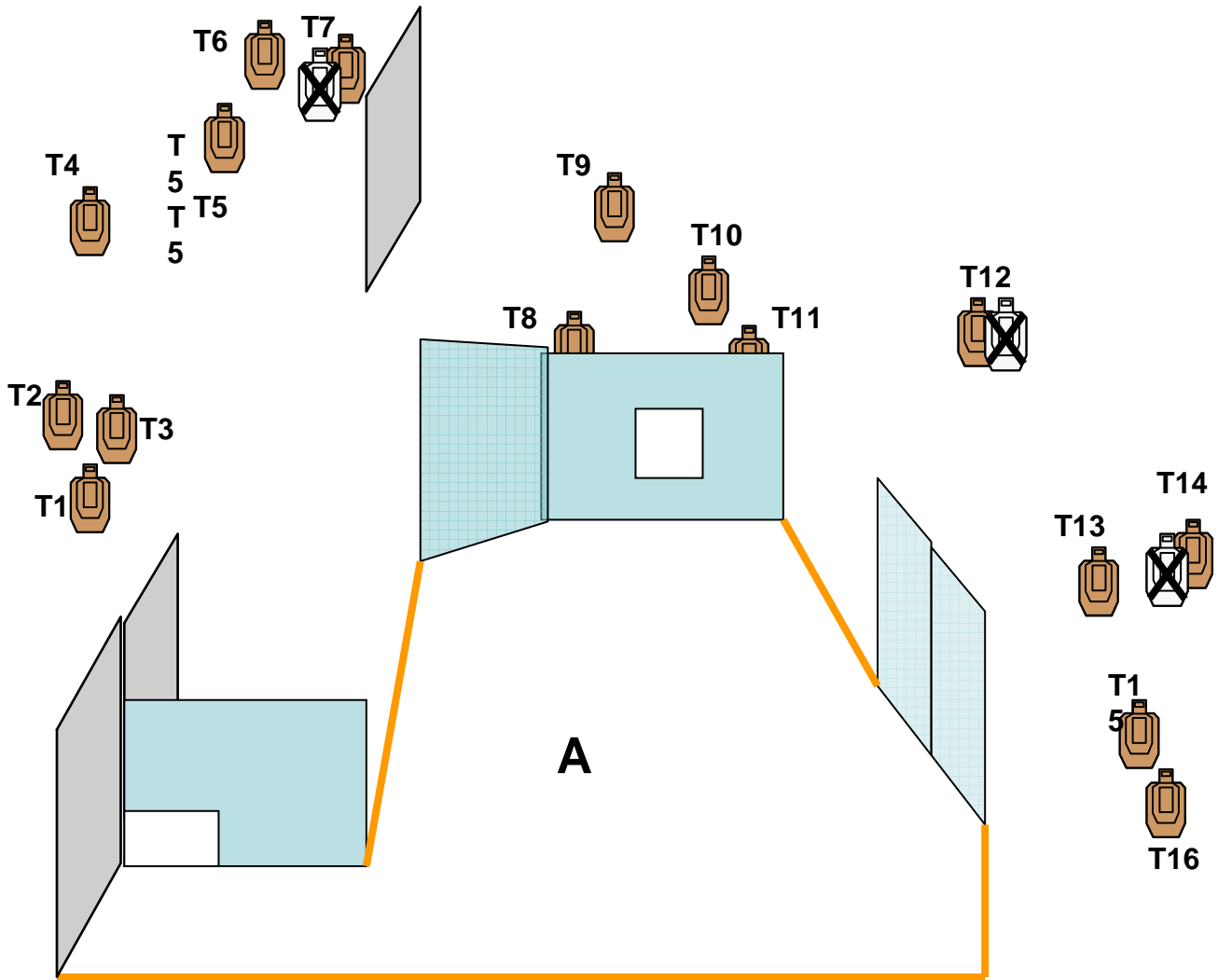


# 2009 AREA 3 CHAMPIONSHIP

## Stage 1

Course Designer: Tom Howard. modified by ENPS committee

<b>START POSITION:</b> Standing anywhere in area A, hands naturally at sides.	
<b>GUN READY CONDITION:</b> Gun loaded and holstered per 8.1.1 or 8.1.2	<b>SCORING:</b> Comstock, 160 points, 32 rounds <b>TARGETS:</b> 16 Metric <b>SCORED HITS:</b> Best two paper <b>START-STOP:</b> Audible- last shot
<b>STAGE PROCEDURE:</b> Upon start signal, engage as visible from within fault lines	<b>RULES:</b> Current USPSA rule book



**Set up notes –** T1-T3 not visible from prone port. T5-T7 should only be visible from prone port. T8, T9, T11 should only be visible from center port, port is kneeling height.

**RO NOTES –** Watch 180 through course. Have shooter kneel or stand before holstering if finished at prone port.



## 2009 AREA 3 CHAMPIONSHIP Stage 2

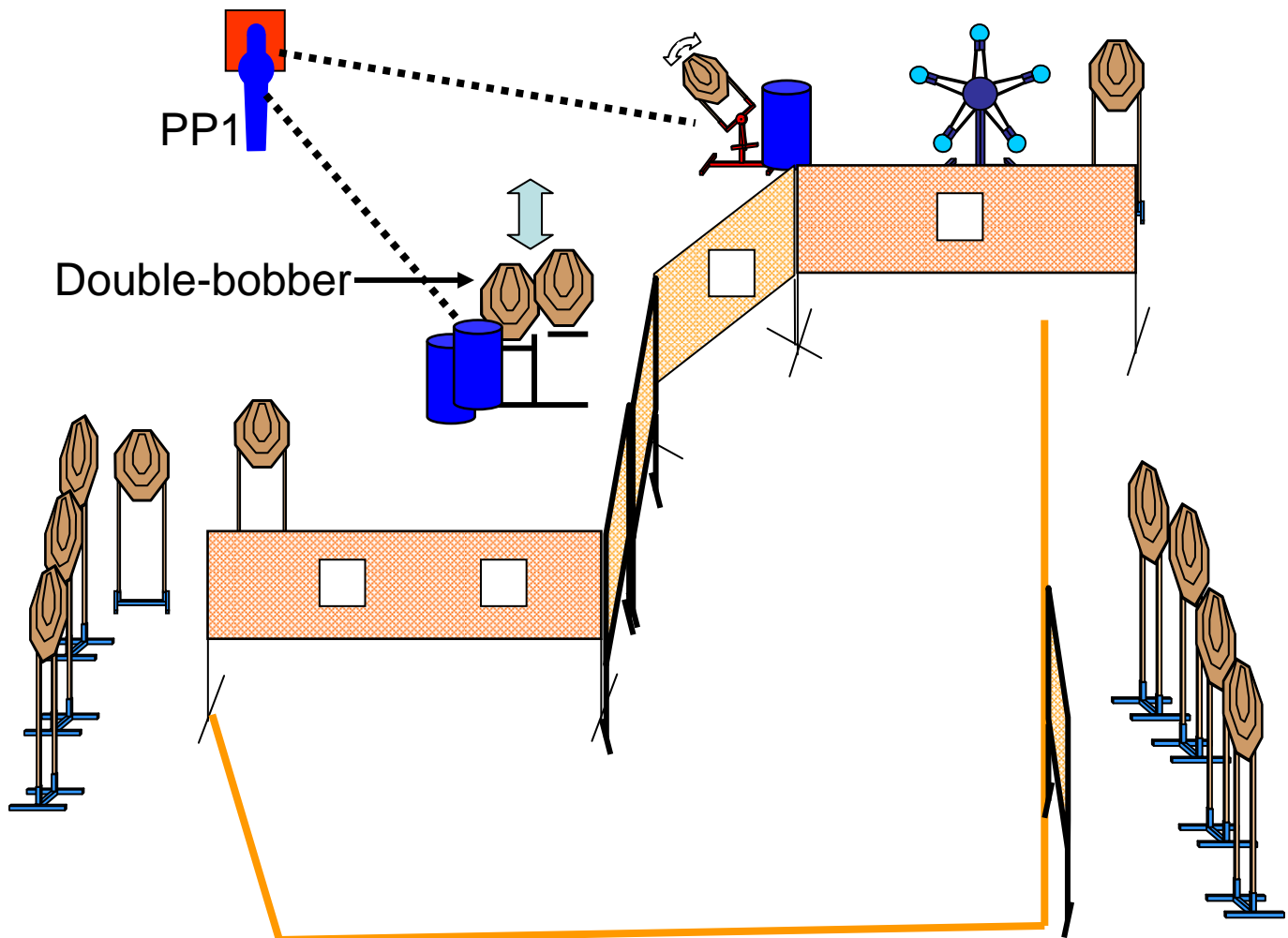
**START POSITION:** Standing anywhere with both heels touching rear fault line, hands naturally at sides.

**GUN READY CONDITION:** Gun loaded and holstered per 8.1.1 or 8.1.2

**SCORING:** Comstock, 160 points, 32 rounds  
**TARGETS:** 13 classic, 1 pepper popper 5 plates  
**SCORED HITS:** Best two paper, steel knockdown = 1A

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Upon start signal, engage as visible from within shooting area. Steel must fall to score.

**START-STOP:** Audible- last shot  
**RULES:** Current USPSA rule book



Set up notes – PP1 activates pressure pad to activate the double-bobber and swinger. D-B & swinger hidden behind barrels to start.



# 2009 AREA 3 CHAMPIONSHIP

## Stage 3

Course Designer: Mark Richman, Modified ENPS Committee

**START POSITION:** Standing behind wall, hands flat on X's.

**GUN READY CONDITION:** Gun loaded and holstered per 8.1.1 or 8.1.2

**SCORING:** Comstock, 120 points, 24 rounds

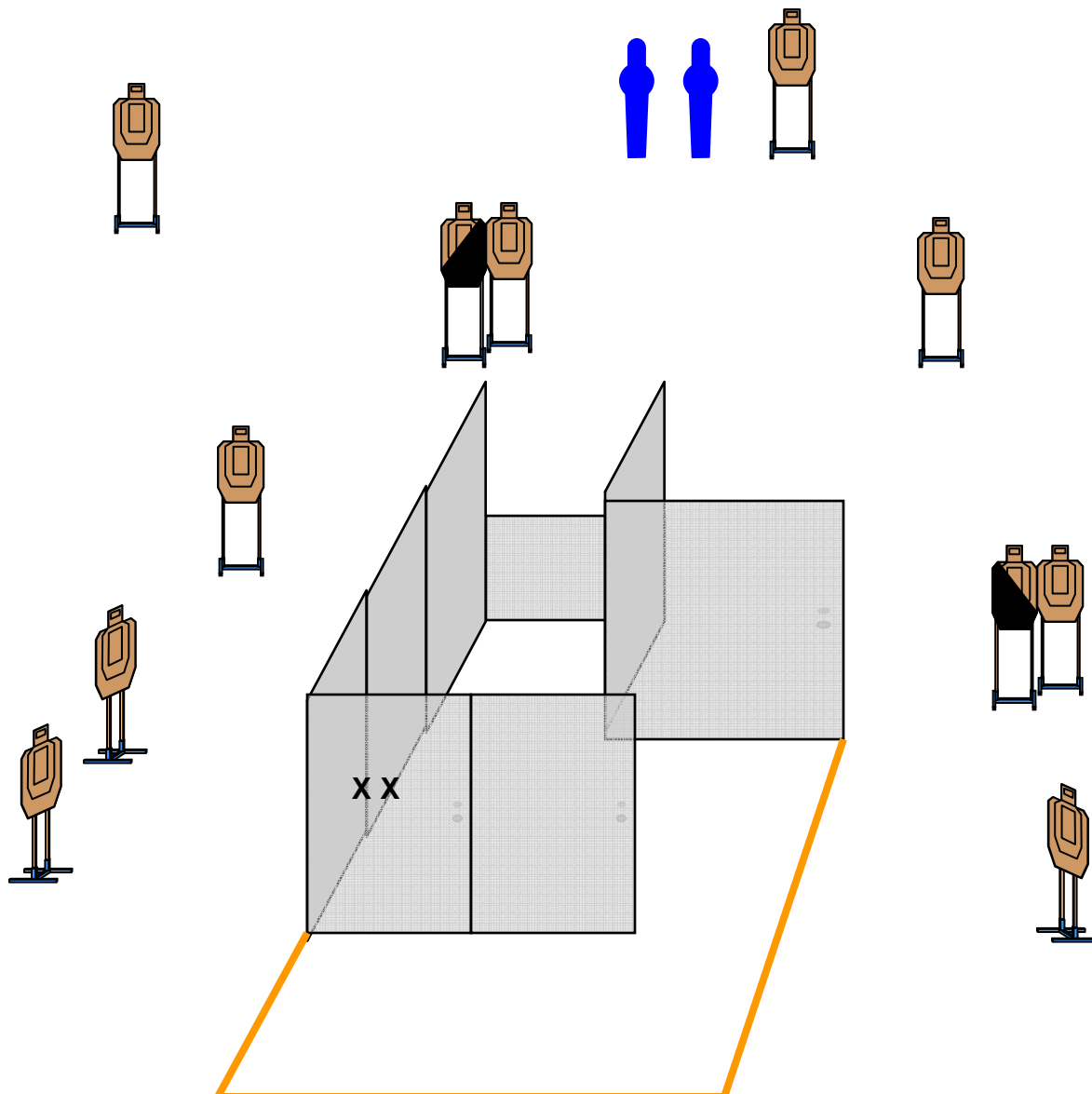
**TARGETS:** 11 metric, 2 pepper popper

**SCORED HITS:** Best two paper, steel knockdown = 1A

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Upon start signal, engage targets as visible from within shooting area. Steel must fall to score.

**START-STOP:** Audible- last shot

**RULES:** Current USPSA rule book





## 2009 Area Three Championship Stage 4

Course Designer: Fred Chovanec, modified by ENPS Committee

**START POSITION:** Standing facing up range toes of both feet on or touching rear fault line, wrists above respective shoulders.

**GUN READY CONDITION:** Gun loaded per 8.1.1 or 8.1.2, laying flat on table at X. All magazines to be used on and retrieved from table. No propping of gun

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Upon start signal, turn and open to door to retrieve gun and magazines. Engage targets as visible from within shooting area. Door activates windmill. Do not cross door threshold. Steel must fall to score.

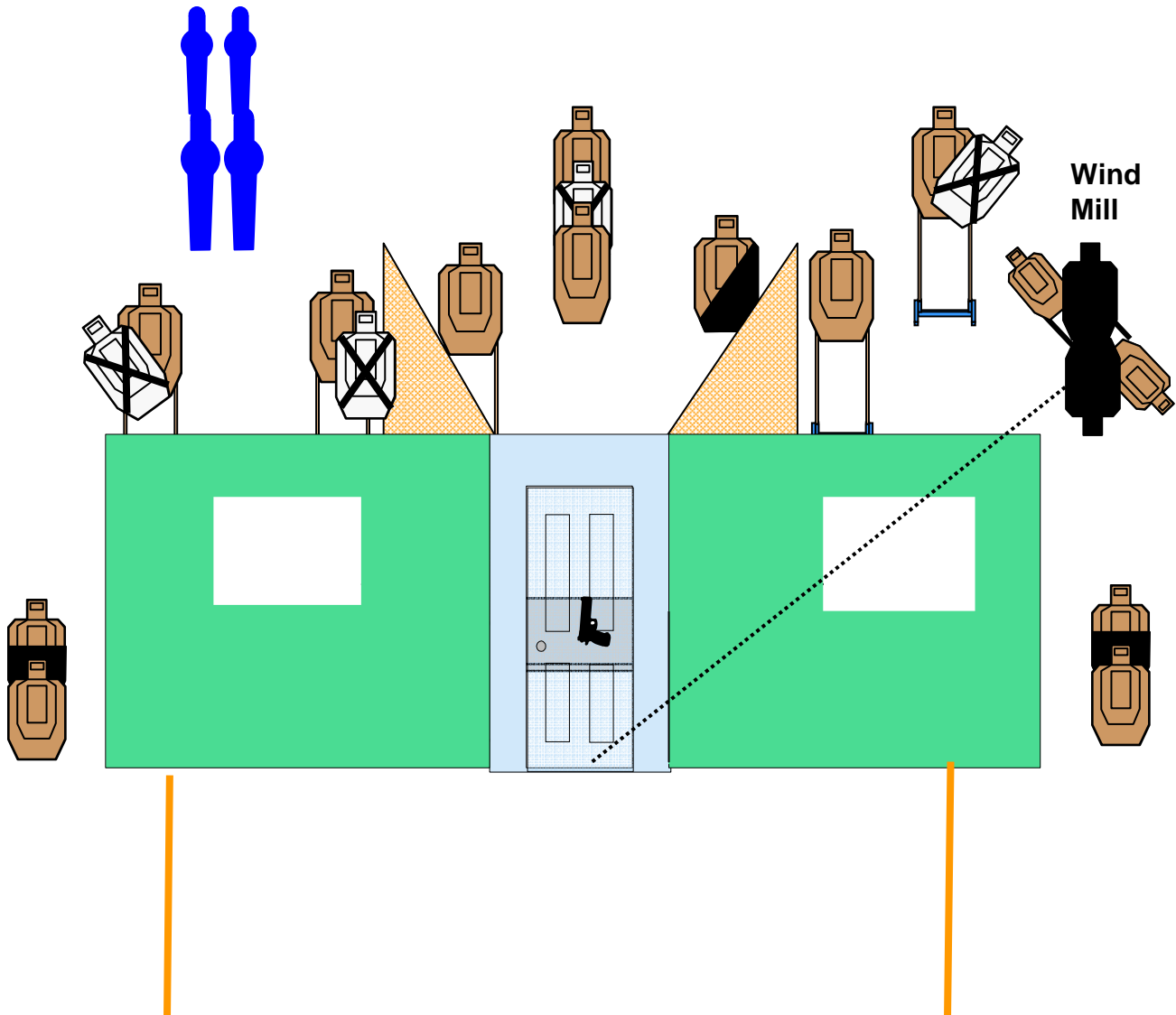
**SCORING:** Comstock, 160 points, 32 rounds

**TARGETS:** 14 metric, 2 pepper popper 2 mini popper

**SCORED HITS:** Best two paper, steel knockdown = 1A

**START-STOP:** Audible- last shot

**RULES:** Current USPSA rule book



Set up notes – mini poppers hidden behind pepper poppers

## Stage 5 – Manny’s ???

Course Designer: Emanuel Bragg, modified by ENPS committee

**START POSITION:** Standing, toes touching X's, hand naturally relaxed at sides.

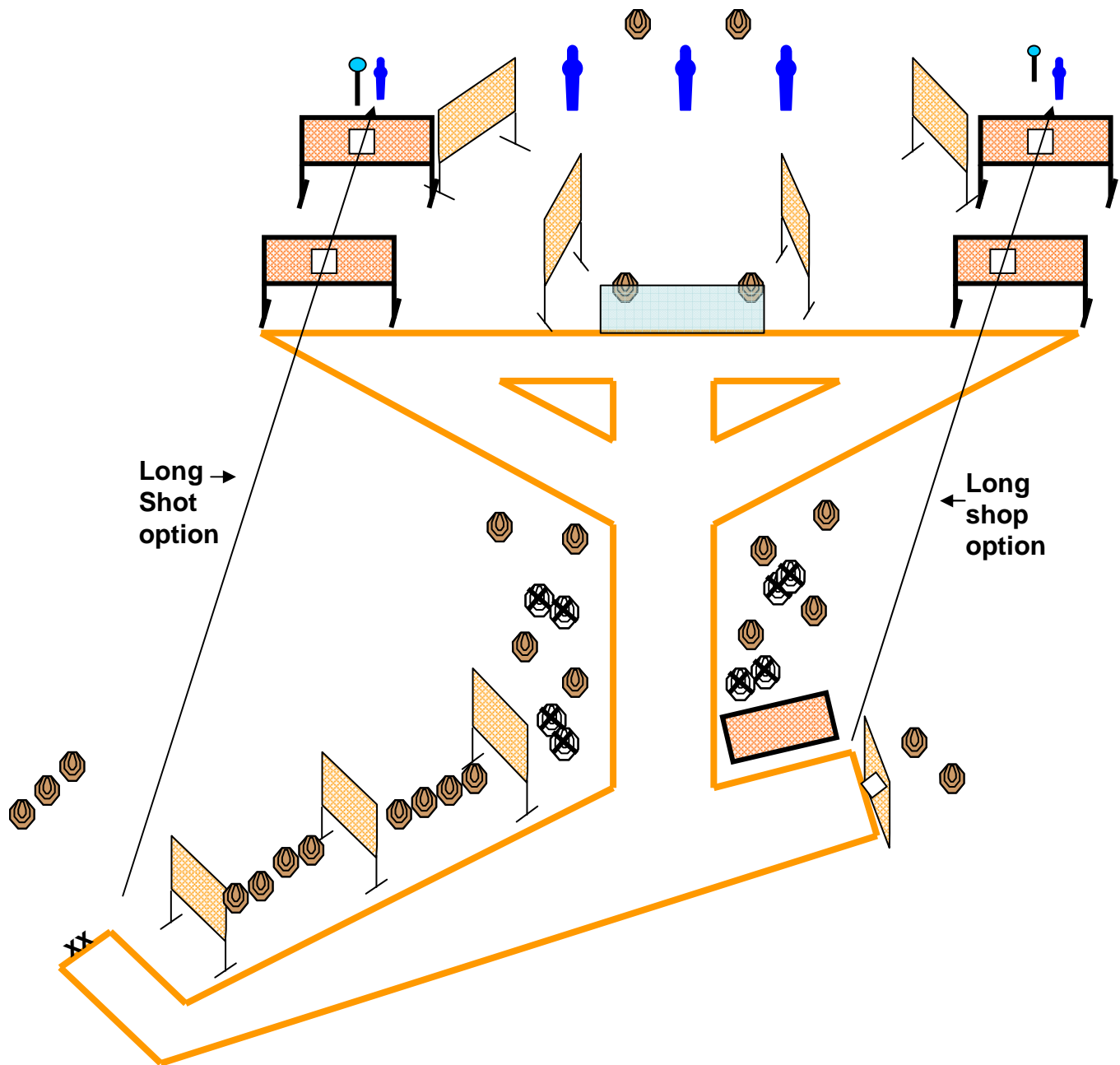
**GUN READY CONDITION:** Gun loaded and holstered per 8.1.1 or 8.1.2

**SCORING:** Comstock, 160 points, 32 rounds  
**TARGETS:** 25 classic, 2 mini popper, 2 plates  
3 pepper poppers

**SCORED HITS:** Best 1 paper, steel  
knockdown = 1A

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** On signal, engage targets as visible from within fault lines, 1 round each. Steel must fall to score.

**START-STOP:** Audible- last shot  
**RULES:** Current USPSA rule book





# 2009 AREA 3 CHAMPIONSHIP STAGE 6

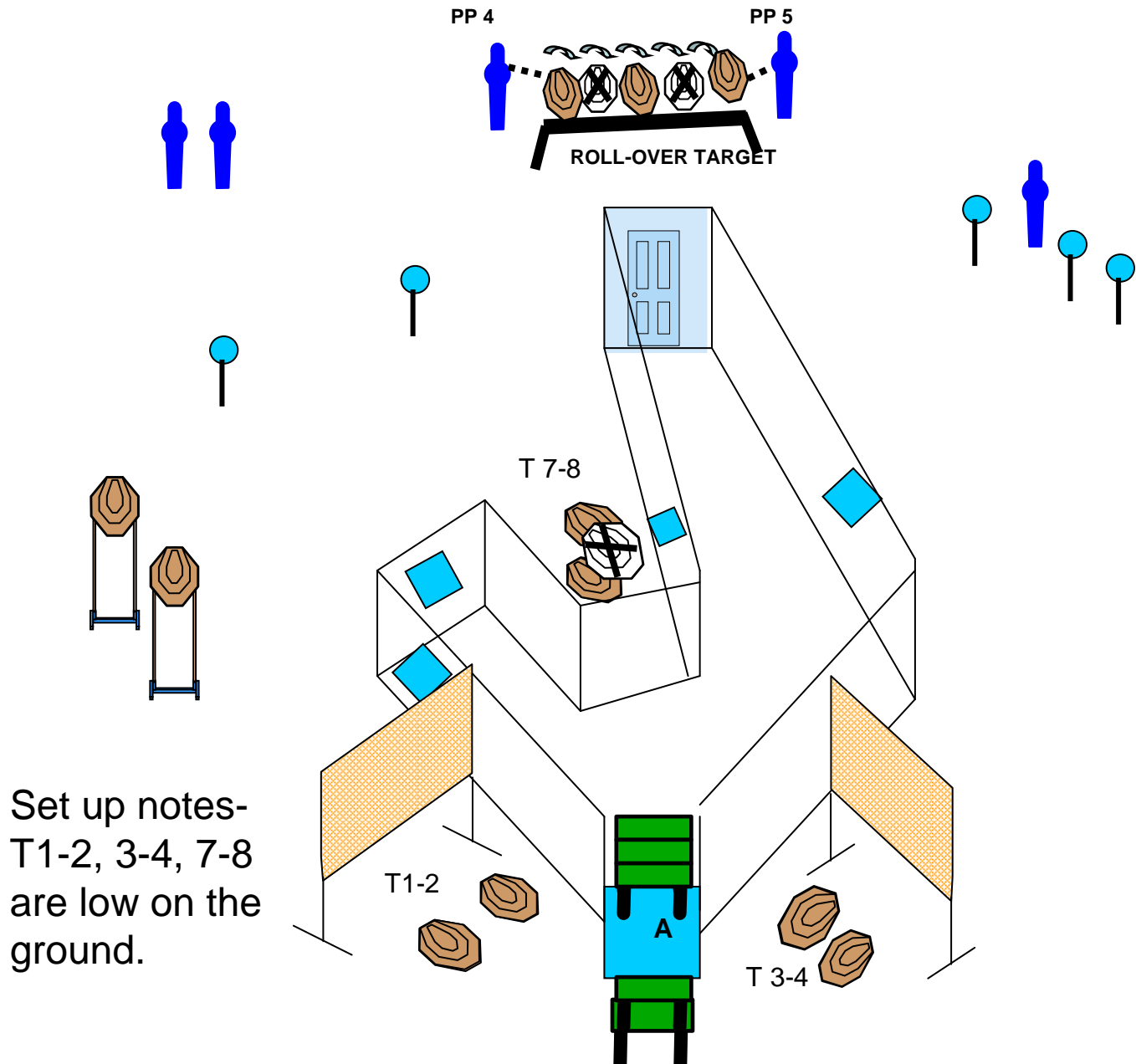
Course Designer: Rich Simandl, Modified ENPS Committee

**START POSITION:** Starting on raised platform, facing down-range, hands naturally at sides.

**GUN READY CONDITION:** Gun loaded and holstered per 8.1.1 or 8.1..2

**SCORING:** Comstock, 160 Points, 32 rounds  
**TARGETS:** 11 Classic, 5 mini popper, 5 steel plates  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 paper, Steel knock down = 1A  
**START-STOP:** Audible- last shot  
**RULES:** Current USPSA rule book

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Starting on platform A, engage targets when visible. Popper 4 or 5 activates flipper, 2 targets disappearing, last 1 stands. Steel must fall to score. Do not cross door threshold.





## 2009 AREA 3 CHAMPIONSHIP Stage 7

Course Designer: Rich Simandl, modified by ENPS committee

**START POSITION:** Standing heels on rear fault line at X's, hands at naturally at sides.

**GUN READY CONDITION:** Gun loaded and holstered per 8.1.1 or 8.1.2

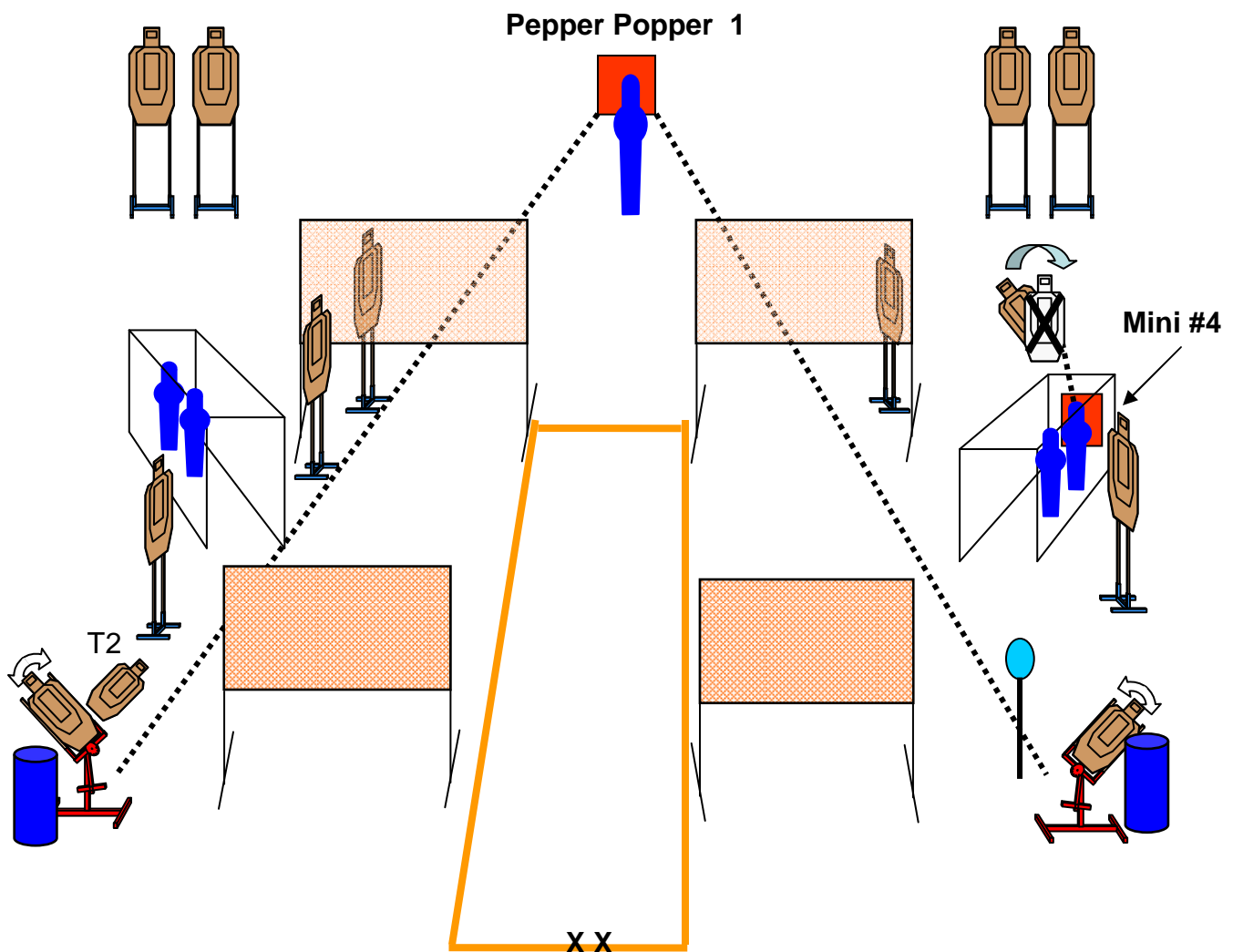
**SCORING:** Comstock, 160 points, 32 rounds  
**TARGETS:** 13 metric, 1 pepper popper, 4 mini popper, 1 plate

**SCORED HITS:** Best two paper, steel  
knockdown = 1A

**START-STOP:** Audible- last shot

**RULES:** Current USPSA rule book

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Upon start signal, engage targets as visible. Pepper popper 1 activates both swingers with pressure pad. Right rear mini popper #4 activates drop-out target. Steel must fall to score.



Set up notes – shooter may need to bend/squat down to be able to see poppers in boxes. 1 forward, 1 rear falling popper in each box. RT popper activates pressure pad to activate Drazy drop-out target. T2 attached to swinger visible when stationary.



# 2009 AREA 3 CHAMPIONSHIP Stage 8

**START POSITION:** Standing behind barricade hands flat on X's

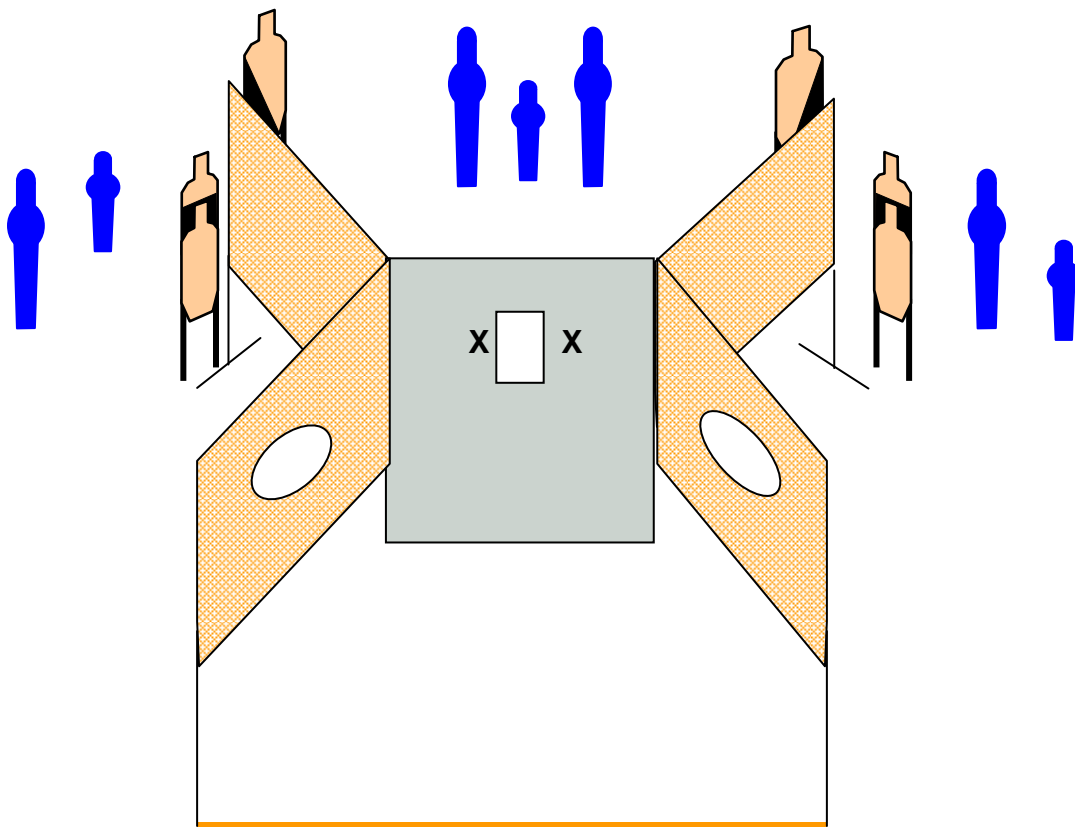
**GUN READY CONDITION:** Gun loaded and holstered per 8.1.1 or 8.1.2

**SCORING:** Comstock, 95 points, 19 rounds  
**TARGETS:** 6 metric, 4 pepper popper 3 mini popper

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Upon start signal, engage as visible from within shooting area. Steel must fall to score.

**SCORED HITS:** Best two paper, steel knockdown = 1A

**START-STOP:** Audible- last shot  
**RULES:** Current USPSA rule book





## 2009 Area Three Championship Stage 9

Course Designer: Rich Simandl Modified by ENPS committee

**START POSITION:** Seated, hands flat on table, back fully against chair, knees under table edge.

**GUN READY CONDITION:** Gun loaded and holstered per 8.1.1 or 8.1.2

**SCORING:** Comstock, 120 points, 24 rounds

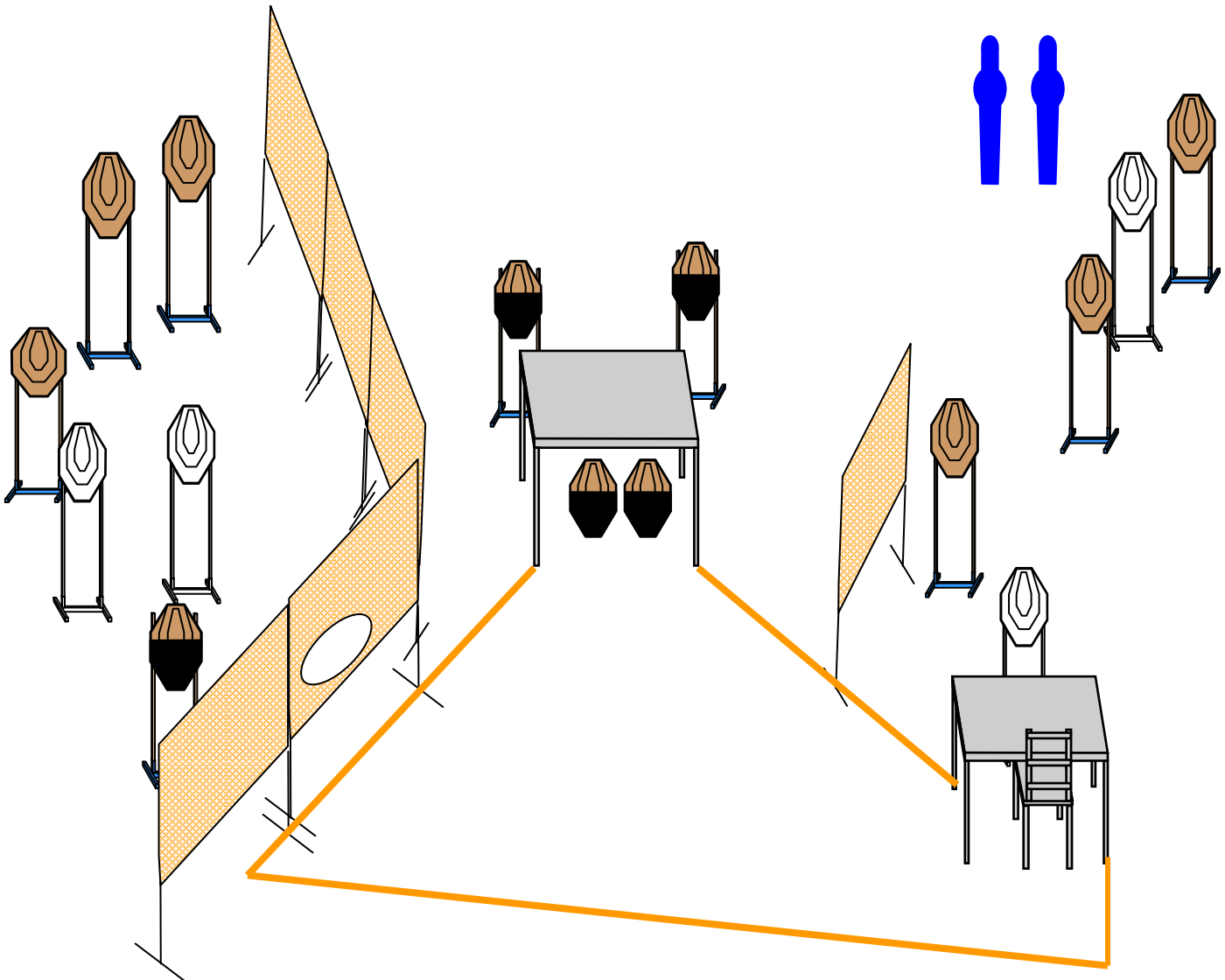
**TARGETS:** 11 Classic, 2 mini popper

**SCORED HITS:** Best two paper, steel  
knockdown = 1A

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Upon start signal, engage when visible from within fault lines. Steel must fall to score.

**START-STOP:** Audible- last shot

**RULES:** Current USPSA rule book



**Set up notes:** Targets under table set to the back so shooter  
Has to bend down/squat to shoot them.



**2009 AREA 3 CHAMPIONSHIP**  
**Stage 10 CM 99-08 Melody Lane Classifier**  
Course Designer:

**START POSITION:** Standing in box A, back to targets, toes of both feet against rear fault line of box A, both wrists above respective shoulders.

**GUN READY CONDITION:** Gun loaded and holstered per 8.1.1 or 8.1.2

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Upon start signal, turn, then draw and from box A engage T1-T6 with 1 round per target, then make a mandatory reload and from box A engage T1-T6 with 1 round per target.

**SCORING:** Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 point  
**TARGETS:** 6 Metric  
**SCORED HITS:** Best two paper, steel  
**START-STOP:** Audible- last shot  
**RULES:** Current USPSA rule book  
Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.

**START POSITION:** Standing in shooting area, all 5 fingers of both hands touching X's

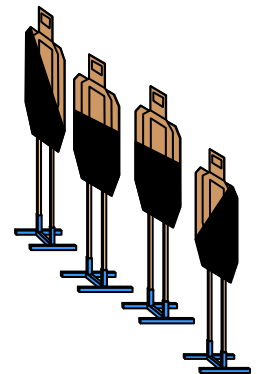
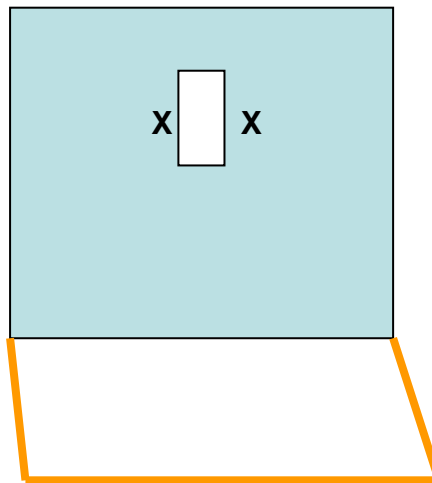
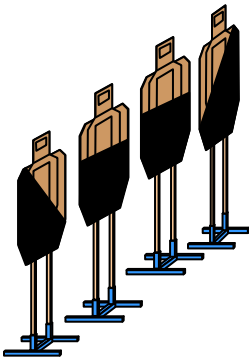
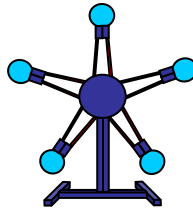
**GUN READY CONDITION:** Gun loaded and holstered per 8.1.1 or 8.1.2

**SCORING:** Comstock, 105 points, 21 rounds

**TARGETS:** 8 metric, 5 plates  
**SCORED HITS:** Best two paper, steel knockdown = 1A

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Upon start signal, engage targets as visible from within shooting area. Steel must fall to score.

**START-STOP:** Audible- last shot  
**RULES:** Current USPSA rule book

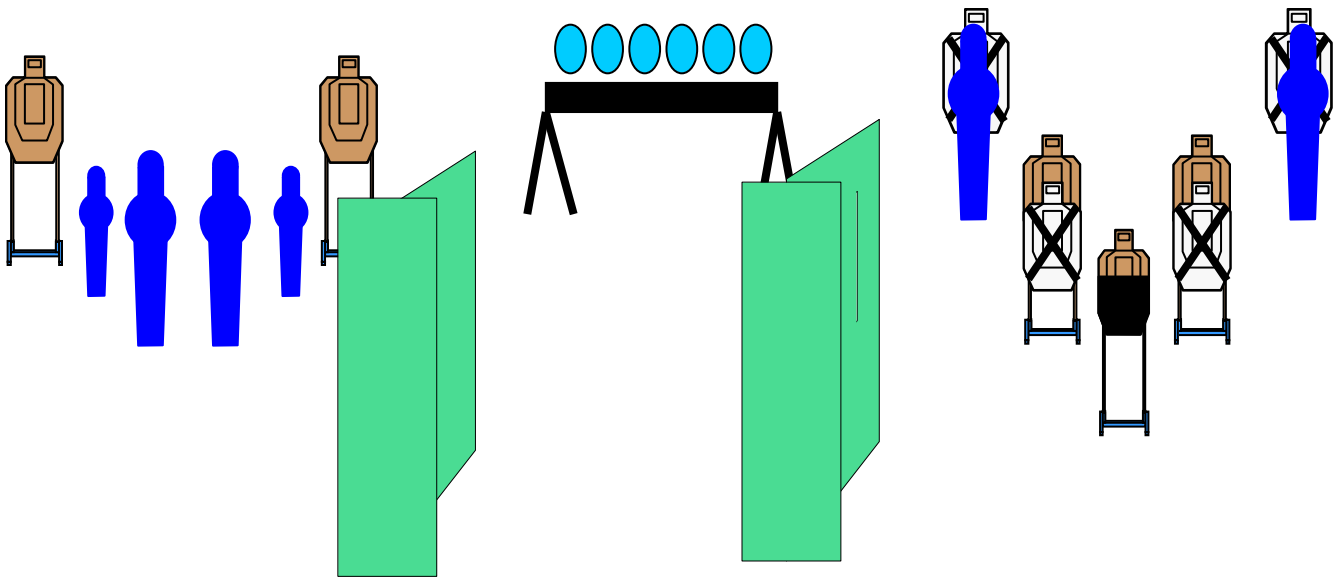


**Set up notes:** port is 1' by 2', 4' above ground

<b>START POSITION:</b> Standing anywhere in shooting area, hands naturally at sides.	
<b>GUN READY CONDITION:</b> Gun loaded and holstered per 8.1.1 or 8.1.2	<b>SCORING:</b> Comstock, 110 points, 22 rounds <b>TARGETS:</b> 5 metric, 4 pepper popper, 2 mini popper, 6 plates <b>SCORED HITS:</b> Best two paper, steel knockdown = 1A
<b>STAGE PROCEDURE:</b> Upon start signal, engage targets as visible from within shooting area. Steel must fall to score.	<b>START-STOP:</b> Audible- last shot <b>RULES:</b> Current USPSA rule book



**Set up notes:** Position "T" walls so not all targets can be seen from 1 shooting position
