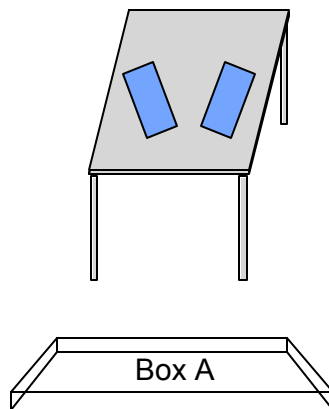
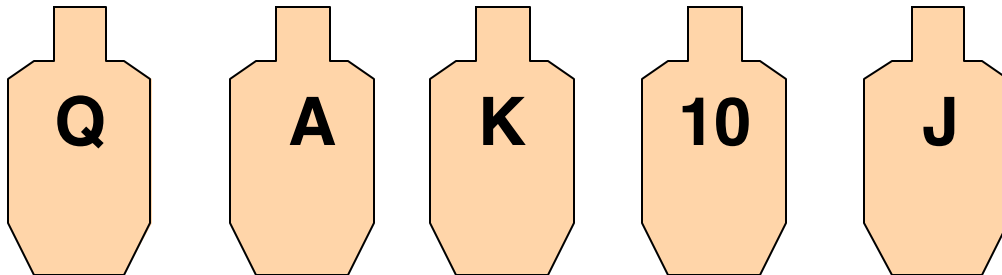
START POSITION: Standing in shooting Box A, facing downrange, arms relaxed at sides, 2 cards face down on the table.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, turn over the 2 cards on the table. Each card corresponds in face value to the marking on one of the 5 IPSC targets. The targets identified by the card faces become designated no-shoot targets. Draw and engage identified shoot targets with only 2 rounds each, make a mandatory reload, engage identified shoot targets with only 2 rounds each.

SCORING

SCORING: Virginia count, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 3 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 4 per IPSC
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Extra shot. -10
Extra hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Order of targets shown above is a suggestion only. Placing the targets in a non-sequential order makes the stage more 'challenging'. Box A is considered to be a 'shooting box'.

RO NOTES: Place only 2 cards on the table to simplify matters. Ensure you have a 'valid hand'. Have an assistant handle the cards for you.
